



Skilled Nursing & Rehabilitation Facility Private Pay List of Services / Costs

Daily Room Rates (Rates effective January 1, 2021)

Short-Term Rehabilitation Private Room: \$300 / day

Long-Term Care Private Room: \$280 / day

Long-Term Care Semi-Private Room: \$272 / day

Long-Term Care Semi-Private Room Rented as Private: \$365 / day

Required Billing Information:

Please remit the following to the Business Office for billing purposes. This will assure verification of insurance coverage and allow for correct billing.

- Medicare Card (red, white and blue card)
- Medicare Supplemental Insurance Card (s)
- Insurance Cards
- Long-term Nursing Home Insurance Policy Information
- Medicaid Card (Forward Card)

Optional services *not* included in the daily rate, which are provided by and billed by Dove Healthcare – Osseo:

- Oxygen
- Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Speech Therapy

***Special food items and supplements:** Special requests for particular food items/supplements by a resident/family member, which is not considered nutritionally necessary and is not a part of our menu, will be honored when possible at a charge to that resident. The nutritional services manager and consulting dietitian will determine what is nutritionally necessary.

Cable TV:

Dove Healthcare – Osseo provides free cable for short-term rehabilitation patients and long-term care residents. Televisions are provided for patients residing in the short-term unit. Long-term care residents will need to furnish his/her own television.

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 **Telephone:**

Dove Healthcare – Osseo provides free telephone service for short-term rehabilitation patients and long-term care residents. Telephones are provided for patients residing in the short-term unit. Long-term care residents will need to furnish his/her own telephone, if service is desired.

 **Transportation**

New Admission Transportation: There is no transportation charge for (local) new admissions to Dove Healthcare – Osseo.

Appointments: We will schedule transportation with the provider of your choice or transportation can be provided by family. Contact the Health Unit Coordinator (HUC) for assistance.

 **Pharmacy**

Costs for pharmacy supplies and medications are available through Health Direct at 715-832-3780 or the pharmacy of the resident's choice. Health Direct will send bills to residents.

 **Podiatry, Audiology, & Dental Services**

Podiatry, dental and audiology services are provided by the resident's choice of provider. Consult with provider for fee information.

 **Daily or Sunday Papers:**

Residents may order newspapers individually and the newspapers will be delivered to individual rooms. Billing arrangements are made directly with the newspaper company.

 **Dry Cleaning:**

Each individual provider determines cost for dry cleaning.

 **Guest Meals:**

\$3 / breakfast meal and \$4 / lunch and supper meal (prices will vary during holidays)

 **Hair Care:**

Services provided by a licensed hair stylist. Ask the social worker for rates.
